COMMUNICATION

TRANSPORT TO THE CLUB

Transfers to the Marina de Vilamoura Sailing Club will be available via boats departing near the Tivoli pontoon. Teams may also walk around the marina (approx. 25 minutes) or travel by car (approx. 10 minutes).

ROOM ASSIGNMENT & CHANGES

Room allocations are determined by the Organizing Committee. Any change must be requested by the team leader or national federation and is subject to approval and availability.

ACCREDITATION CARD

At the registration you will collect your accreditation card. For identification and security purposes, you will have to wear your accreditation card at all times during the event (at the venues, at the hotel and during our ceremonies).
