1. Loulé's market: Traditional market and a taste of local flavors

Since the earliest of times, Loulé has been a center of great commercial activity as well known for the craftsmen (coppersmith, palm weavers or potters). Nowadays, we can still see some of them working at their workshops.

But, the Loulé's Market is the main atraction here: a magnificent edifice of neo-Arabic style, with more 100 years, that extends the bustle to the surrounding streets.

Here we can find all sorts of local products, such as fresh vegetables, fish and fruits that grow in Loulé's surrounding. In this tour we will visit the old and traditional city of Loulé, some special people that make the place alive and get the opportunity to taste the regional pastries, in a local familiar factory, taste dried fruits and in the end we'll taste some traditional "Petiscos" served in a typical Portuguese restaurant.

2. Cataplana Experience: From the Market to the plate

The term "Cataplana" refers not only to the object itself, but also to the recipes made with it. The characteristics of this copper pan allow the creation of a great diversity of recipes, which delight the five senses and the heart, because the cataplana allows the use of little fat in the preparations. During this experience, you will have the opportunity to discover all the potential of the most iconic gastronomic utensil in the Algarve, learning how to make a cataplana recipe.

The tour starts with a guided tour thought Faro Market, with a Chef, in order to meet the local products and to buy some of them for the next stage: the making off the Cataplana. This will take part in a local restaurant where you'll learn how to do it and, of course, to taste it!

4. Ria Formosa's Natural park

Why would you miss out on the opportunity to see or to listen to a Blue Winged Magpie? Or get a look on the special Audouinnis Gull? Put together birds and their calls with the help of a true specialist with 30 years of birdwatching experience.

Walk along the natural park where several species of birds of prey occur. Booted Eagle and Marsh Harrier or the Hoopoe could be the highlights of the day, among several passerine and aquatic species such as Little Tern, Red Crested Pochard, Purple Swamphen, to name but a few.

The secretive Little Bittern and the exotic Black-headed Weaver also occur in this area. Join us on this surprising experience!





5. Salgados Lagoon

Enjoy a close contact with nature while discovering some of Algarve's colourful birds, as, for example, the rare Purple Swamphen or the Bluethroat. Small walk along Salgados lagoon, one of the region's most renowned birdwatching hotspots, where Black-winged Stilt, Greater Flamingo, Spoonbill, Mediterranean Gull, Marsh Harrier and many waders occur.

This is also an area of important occurrence of the rare Squacco Heron, Audouin's Gull and Ferruginous Duck. Discover these and many other bird species with the help of our specialized birdwatching guide with 30 years of field experience and writer of some Algarve's birdbooks. You will be guided through this remarkable nature experience by a true specialist!

6. Water route: Walk in the protected area of Fonte da Benémola

North of Loulé, close to Serra do Caldeirão, we find a very special green valley: Fonte da Benémola. An area declared as a protected park due to its enormous natural richness. More than 300 species of plants and numerous wild birds can be observed here. All due to the abundant and permanent presence of water, which flows permanently from several natural springs, giving this place a very special value.

On this easy and very accessible walk for families, we will follow through some of the trails in this valley, admire its biodiversity and learn a little about the history of this space that has been used for centuries by local people for traditional agriculture because its abundant presence of water, also with medicinal properties.

7. Hiking along ancient paths

For centuries the Algarve's countryside has been the home of many civilizations, including the Romans or the Arabs. Some of their physical testimonies are still present there, including rocky paths, water engines, graves or just names of places.

Nature already took back some of these places, but its still posssible to walk there and contact with an amaizing beauty! Hundreds of wild plants, including orchids, roses, thyme, narcissus and many other can be seen in this walk, most in spring, but also many birds, small tradicional farms.

This is a great hike to enjoy the wonders of the Algarve countryside in its most traditional and genuine state!
